

Sting Ray FAQ

Q. How does the Stingray differ from other units on the market today?

A. Generally speaking, the Stingray was invented to provide a client with superior performance primarily based on labor savings for small/medium size facilities.

Q. How much faster is the Stingray versus the backpack applicators?

A. Our time studies indicate a 40% savings in labor alone!

Q. Is the pail included with the Stingray DDA?

A. Yes. Our proprietary reusable pail is part of our patented design! Simply unscrew the lid and pour your chemical of choice into the Pail. The unused portion can remain in our pail for future use.

Q. How does the Stingray DDA actually dispense the floor finish, or coating, to the flooring surface?

A. Our Stingray allows the operator to simply connect our proprietary reusable 5 gallon on the Stingray. Insert the handle to the faucet, and turn the handle to release the finish to the floor. Walk a "bead" for about 20 feet and turn the Stingray "OFF". Take the Stinger hand tool from the tray and using a key pattern spread the finish. Repeat the process until your project is complete.

Q. What are the savings in chemical as it relates to this innovation?

A. Our studies indicate a chemical savings to be between 7 – 12%.

There is also an additional labor savings predicated on the fact that set-up for the Stingray is less than 1 minute, and clean-up is 70% less than backpack units or other similar applicators.

Q. How does ease of use compare the backpack unit with the Stingray?

A. First, the Stingray is easily pulled versus wearing and carrying a clumsy backpack unit. Second, our dispensing feature is much more efficient than the backpack “squeeze” method. Third, the Stingray requires no transfer of sticky floor finish whereas the backpack does. Also, in most cases the backpack requires the user to buy a specific brand of chemical, therefore locking you into only one brand.

Q. Is the Stingray pitched?

A. Yes, the slight 8 degree pitch allows for about 98% of the chemical to be dispensed to the floor from our reusable 5 gallon pail.

Q. Is the transport tray permanently attached to the Stingray DDA?

A. No! The tray is removable for ease of rinsing.

Q. Can I apply wood coatings with a backpack?

A. No! You can, however, use the Stingray DDA for wood coatings.

We suggest you spread the coating with a T-bar instead of our Stinger tool for this application.

Q. What are the benefits of the Stingray compared to a mop-bucket method?

A. Stingray DDA offers less fatigue, faster, easier, more capacity, zero waste, and is ergonomically and environmentally responsible.

Q. What brand of finish, sealer, and coatings can be used?

A. You can use your brand of choice with the Stingray as we DO NOT endorse any specific brands. We only offer innovative application products.
